



Introduction to Free Trade Zones

A Free trade Zones (FTZ) also called by the names Free Zones (FZ), Free Economic Zones (FEZ), or Free Economic territories (FEts) are one or more areas of the country where tariffs & quotas are eliminated, and bureaucratic requirements are lowered to attract companies by floating the incentives for doing business there.

Free trade Zones are proved to be effective & useful means to develop new markets and to increase earnings from foreign trade. Most of the Free trade zones are located in developed and developing countries. They are special zones where typical trade barriers such as import or export tariffs do not apply; bureaucracy is typically minimized by outsourcing it to FTZ operators. Companies can seek sheltered areas best suited to their needs.



Free Trade Zones in the United Arab Emirates (UAE)

Free Zones in the Middle East, particularly the UAE, have come a long way in the last few decades, becoming liberal in terms of incentives and attracting diverse business sectors. Located along the Persian Gulf within the Middle East, the UAE has profited from a worldwide trade as a transshipment location between Asia and Europe. Besides, as the region lessens its dependence on oil exports, it is encouraging diversification into other industries.

A free zone company is not allowed to trade directly with the UAE market, and the free zone company can trade within the UAE only through locally appointed distributors. A customs duty of 5% is applicable when the free zone company sells in the local market, and employees with visas from free zone companies are expected to work only from the company's offices in that free zone. Regarding import licensing, inside the UAE, only firms with an appropriate trade license can engage in the importation, and only UAE registered businesses, which must have at least 51 percent ownership by a UAE national, can obtain such a license. This licensing provision does not apply to goods imported into free zones. Some goods for personal consumption do not require import licenses.



To date, the Free Zones in the UAE have been effective in attracting a large number of foreign investors and FDI. The share of the Free Zones in non-oil exports has amplified significantly along with the net exports from the Free Zones. The advantages offered by various Free Zones of the UAE include:

An independent Free Zone Authority (FZA) oversees each free zone and is the agency accountable for issuing FTZ business licenses and assisting companies with establishing their business in the FTZ.



Free Zones in Abu Dhabi

Abu Dhabi is the largest trading port linking the West and East of the world. Foreign business formation in Abu Dhabi is still having very high values among the international market. It is the United Arab Emirates' federal capital and the largest of the seven emirates, occupying more than 80% of the country's total land. There are several free zones in Abu Dhabi, which offer a favorable environment for business setup in the Emirates and provide a gateway for foreign investors to tap its full potential.

A free zone in Abu Dhabi is an area within the Emirates separate from the rest of the country in which all sorts of goods are used for trading purposes. Goods can be introduced regardless of nature, source, origin, or place of arrival. These products are not subjected to import duties or any other unknown taxes.

Abu Dhabi's free zones are a part of the Emirate's economic diversification initiative to boost the local economy and promote foreign investment. Business setup in free zones comprises media and light companies, logistics companies, and medium & heavy industries. There are many incentives and facilities that shareholders receive by setting up a company in Abu Dhabi free zones, which is the key driving force behind company formation in Abu Dhabi.



Different Free Zones in Abu Dhabi

There are eight free zones in Abu Dhabi.
They are explained below -



Abu Dhabi Airport Free Zone (ADAFZ)

Abu Dhabi Business Center was launched in March 2006 to persuade significant improvement in the Emirates Aviation sector. SkyCity, a subsidiary of Abu Dhabi Airports Company, is responsible for developing Abu Dhabi Airport Free Zone (ADAFZ), a comprehensive business park in the vicinity of Abu Dhabi International Airport. It offers regular free zone benefits, like, world-class infrastructural facilities, tax exemptions, and 100% foreign company ownership, etc. to investors belonging to Aviation, Airport services, Aerospace, Logistics, Cargo, and Freight sectors, apart from the infrastructural benefits like warehousing and logistic units, land plots, and commercial offices for business setup.

Abu Dhabi Ports Company (ADPC) Free Zone

Abu Dhabi Ports Company (ADPC) or the Khalifa Port is one of the UAE's largest projects. To contribute to the prosperity of Abu Dhabi by increasing trade and inbound investment, the Khalifa Port was incorporated in 2012. Abu Dhabi Port is the regulatory body that controls all the Khalifa Port's trade and master development. The main motive of ADPC is to create sustainable growth that promotes and diversifies the economy of Abu Dhabi by developing its infrastructure, real estate, and business service following the private sector. The primary objective of the Abu Dhabi Port is to develop the Khalifa Port and all other ports (Except the Oil & Gas and Military ports) and related infrastructure in the emirate of Abu Dhabi.

The Khalifa Port is strategically built between Dubai and Abu Dhabi, in Taweelah, which covers 2.7 sq. kilometers of the area, and is the first semi-automated port in the UAE. Companies in the Khalifa Port are benefited from its best-integrated information and communication technology (ICT) and automated marine services. Its comprehensive and well-built connectivity provides access to 52 international maritime ports and around 4.5 billion people within four different time zones. Khalifa port in Abu Dhabi has over 20 shipping lines to support and develop trading at present.

Types of Licenses in Abu Dhabi Port



Trading License

Companies legally registered outside the UAE and involved in activities like import-export can opt for a trade license. A business does not require any special authorization from the Department of Economic Development (DED) for this.



Industrial License

A free zone incorporated company with its activities in the industrial production of products is granted an industrial license. An industrial license permits the company to import raw materials and other products for manufacturing purpose and import the finished & packed goods outside the country.



Service License

Businesses that provide services like banking, management consultancy, or other professional services can go for a UAE's service license. These businesses do not require a separate license from the DED.



National Industrial License

Companies granted a National Industrial License have the same status as that of a local or a Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC) company in the UAE. Any company looking to carry out its business operations in the manufacturing sector can go for a National Industrial License.

Twofour 54 Free Zone

Twofour54 in Abu Dhabi was established in the year 2008 to provide a business hub for local, regional, and international media companies. It is a media-free zone set up by the Media Zone Authority (MZA) to position Abu Dhabi as a regional center of excellence and a prominent player in the Arabic media content creation industry. MZA aims to create a platform for the inclusive development of Arabic media and entertainment content in all spheres (Events, Film, Digital Media, Publishing, Music, Broadcast, Gaming, etc.). Additionally, Twofour54 supervises the implementation of the operational policies and strategies in the free zone. Prominent media houses like Thomson Reuters Foundation, CNN, Financial Times, BBC, etc. have set up their operations in Twofour54. It also has a talent pool of nearly 4,000 professionals, including 600 freelancers.





Khalifa Industrial Zone

The Khalifa Industrial Zone or KIZAD is a visionary project by the Abu Dhabi government to revolutionize the Industrial sector of the emirate. The KIZAD project was revealed in November 2010 by Abu Dhabi Ports and officially began its operations in September 2012. On a greenfield site in Taweeelah, Abu Dhabi, the government set up this multi-billion dollar industrial park to achieve economic diversification by 2030. This industrial park has two vital elements that attract foreign investors: its geographical location and its low operating cost.

The KIZAD free zone in Abu Dhabi occupies a 417 square-kilometer area strategically located halfway between Abu Dhabi and Dubai. KIZAD is divided into two areas, Area A and Area B. While area A is focused on business people operating in the industrial sector, Area B is taken by commerce-based companies. KIZAD gives freedom for both free zone-based companies as well as non-free zone-based companies.
